M Lawrence Wolf Artist

BIOGRAPHY

M Lawrence Wolf is an installation artist, sculptor, and painter. Her exhibition history spans three decades, 142 exhibitions and includes National exhibition awards and recognition. During the 1990's, her work was included in Best of Denver Galleries at the Arvada Center, the Longmont Museum, and numerous invitationals including International exhibitions in Venezuela and China. In 2000, M Lawrence Wolf received a Colorado Council on the Arts Award for "the home place", an Art in Public Places project on the homeless. She represented the Arkansas River Valley of Colorado in Pueblo's Sangre de Cristo Art Center invitational "I-25" during the summer of 2003. In the East, she has participated in numerous community events; and, her work was featured at the Jersey City Museum's Majestic Gallery, a large-scale painting installation entitled "Fluid", June through September, 2009. Recently, she served as Gallery Director and Curator for a contemporary Pueblo gallery, and exhibited a solo show of Assemblage and Painting in Summer, 2015.

Lawrence Wolf's dedication to community art advocacy includes Board membership for the Denver Foundation (1993-1996), Denver's national funding model, the Scientific and Cultural Facilities Tax District (1989-1995), and the National Woman's Caucus for Art-Colorado Chapter (Vice President 1994-1996). Lawrence Wolf is a grant writer and nonprofit consultant, and has raised funds for numerous community organizations, obtained 501(c)3 nonprofit status for cooperative galleries, and assisted with the stabilization of established arts organizations. She served as panelist for Colorado's Art in Public Places projects including Denver International Airport.

As art educator, M Lawrence Wolf has received excellence in art education awards from the Rhode Island School of Design (1990) and U.N.E.S.C.O., Paris (1992); and, has been a guest presenter/lecturer. She has taught at both private and public institutions including the Art Students League of Denver, the Colorado Institute of Art, and Colorado State University-Pueblo. In the 1990's, Lawrence Wolf created an international educational exchange program with Denver Middle school students and students of Cuernavaca, Mexico: and, today continues to be involved in education and cultural exchange programs.
