## **Do you guys take credit cards?!**

Trinity Tattoo Co. is cash only.

## **Can we make appointments over the phone?!**

We do not make appointments over the phone. All appointments require a cash deposit based on the size of the tattoo. Normally it's \$20, but that price goes up with the size of the tattoo.

## **Hey, can you tell me how much this is going to cost?!**

We do not give price quotes over the phone. Come in and talk to us, a small tattoo to you might not mean small to us. Size, shape and placement all effects the price....So, just come in.

## **Do you take walk-ins?**

Sure! But as a walk-in it's first come first served. We don't hold spots for walk-ins..its best to just make an appointment so you have a set time and date for your tattoo.

## **Hey I'm 13, can I get a tattoo?**

No. State age limits for tattoos and piercings are as following. 15 for piercings with Govt issued photo ID (Drivers License, Non-Driver ID,Passport) with your parent present with their ID as well as getting one of our parental permission forms notarized. 16 for tattoos with all the same requirements as piercing.

**Hey, I've had a couple drinks. Can I still get tattooed or pierced?**

No. Other than bleeding a bunch, you won't sit still...which makes our job harder and giving you a great tattoo almost impossible.

**Is it going to hurt?!**

Some people say they hurt a lot and some people say not at all. The truth is, they all hurt. But depending on the spot and length of being tattooed some hurt more than others. If you just relax, breathe and don't fight it you'll be okay. One other thing that helps a lot is to have a good meal before coming in and getting tattooed. If it was really bad you'd never see people with more than one.

**Is it okay to touch my tattoo while getting it?**

This is one of our biggest pet peeves here at Trinity. PLEASE do not touch your tattoo while getting it. It's just gross. You're touching a bleeding open wound, then you're going to touch the chair, the wall, your friends, and then the money you're going to hand the artist. If you touch it you're going to be asked nicely to use hand sanitizer, and if you keep touching it we'll stop being so nice.

**Hey I have a sunburn/peeling..can I get a tattoo?**

No. Sunburns make you bleed a lot while getting tattooed, which makes making nice lines that stay in a problem. When peeling your skin will flake off and clog the needles up and also crack while getting tattooed.

**Can I bring my kids with me?**

Sure, if they're well behaved and you have someone to sit and watch them while getting tattooed/pierced.

**Is there anything you won't tattoo?**

Well as a shop we don't tattoo faces. Also we normally don't tattoo in places like necks, hands, fingers, throats unless you're already pretty heavily tattooed.

# Tattoo Aftercare

Remove bandage after 2 hours. DO NOT REBANDAGE TATTOO!

Wash the tattoo with lukewarm water and antibacterial soap. Use your hands to wash, do not use any washcloths. After washing, pat area dry with paper towels. Repeat 2 to 3 times per day for the first 3 days.

Keep a thin layer of AQUAPHOR ointment on your tattoo at ALL TIMES for the entire healing process. The purpose of applying the ointment is so that the tattoo does not dry out. If it dried out, a scab will form and when the scab falls off, it can cause the tattoo to fall out along with it.

During the entire healing period, make sure to avoid direct sunlight, swimming pools, hot tubs, or salt water. Stay out of everything except the shower.
