

## Electroforming & Enameling



Electroforming is the process of fusing copper onto another object. This is accomplished through the electrodeposition of positive copper ions over a negatively-charged matrix through an electrolytic copper salt solution. This process can transform and strengthen a variety of objects from organic to wax as you can see from the examples above.

**When:** June 1- June 30, 2018

**Format:** This is a self-directed class designed to maximize online learning capabilities.

- Like my other online classes, you will work at your own pace.
- I will share photos, videos and written explanations and will be there to answer questions and give feedback.
- The class takes place via a private Facebook group where class members will share results, ask questions and give feedback to each other.
- What is needed to set up an electroforming bath.

- How to prepare your object and combine different materials for electroforming.
- Safety & troubleshooting.
- Finishing.
